**The crossed swords:** *Represents God's Word is the Christian's weapon in this salvation war. It is a war against Satan and evil. We are fighting for God and for the salvation of lost souls- those who do not know Jesus as their Lord and Savior,*

**The Gospel shots:** *Represent the basic truths of the gospel; there are seven in all:*  
*1. The existence of a holy God*

2. *The evils of sin are against God and man.*
3. *There will be punishment for sin that is fair and everlasting.*
4. *Jesus died on the cross for the human race.*
5. *Salvation is for all mankind and is free to all who accept Jesus Christ.*
6. *It is the responsibility of every Christian to do whatever s/he can do to spread the gospel.*
7. *God rewards those who are faithful with eternal life in heaven with Him.*

**The words 'Blood and Fire':** *The motto of THE SALVATION ARMY It is Jesus' blood that washes us clean from sin and it is the fire of the Holy Spirit that makes us pure and helps us live lives that are pleasing to God*

**The crown:** Represents the crown of life and glory which God will give to all those who have been faithful to Him

*Exodus 20:3 "You shall have no other gods before me."*

**Doctrine 3:** *1 John 5:7 “for there are three that bear witness in heaven, the Father, the Word and the Holy Spirit”*

**Doctrine 4:** *Philippians 2:6-8 “Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross!”*

**Doctrine 5:** *Romans 5:19 “For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.”*

**Doctrine 6:** *John 3:16 “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.”*

**Doctrine 7:** *Hebrews 11: 6 “without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek him.”*

**Doctrine 8:** *Romans 8:16 “The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God’s children.”*

*Philippians 3:9 “and be found in Him (Christ), not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God and is by faith.”*

**Doctrine 9:** *Hebrews 5:7-9 “During the days of Jesus’ life on earth, he offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission. Although he was a son, he learned obedience from what he suffered and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him.”*

**Doctrine 10:** *1 Thessalonians 5:23 “May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.”*

**Doctrine 11:** *Romans 8:10-11 “But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness. And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.”*
