Take as much time as you need on each step. Don't feel like you must complete all eleven steps. The Lord may have you spend a prolonged time on just one. Or, the Lord may direct you to a different focus than what is suggested here. The key is to walk with Jesus, listen, and communion with Him.

The Lord would like to talk to you. Be sure to spend this time with Him. As you move from one passage to another, I encourage you to change locations. This may mean just walking several feet. It is a way of affirming the reality of moving forward with God.

Step 1:



Read John 10:27-28

“My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.”

Focus: Stop and let the Lord speak to you. What is Jesus saying?

Step 2:



Read: Matthew 11:28-30

“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”

Focus: What has wearied or burdened your life? Let the Lord speak to you concerning that burden and invite him put his yoke upon you.

Listen & Pray

Step 3:



Read: Psalm 24:4-5

“He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to an idol or swear by what is false. He will receive blessing from the LORD and vindication from God his Savior.”

Focus: Let the Lord speak to you concerning the condition of your heart and hands.

Listen & Pray

Step 5:



Read: Psalm 86:11-13

“Teach me your way, O LORD, and I will walk in your truth; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name. I will praise you, O Lord my god, with all my heart; I will glorify your name forever. For great is your love toward me; you have delivered me from the depths of the grave.”

Focus: Let the Lord minister to your heart?

Listen & Pray

Step 8:



Read: Psalm 61:1-4

“Hear my cry, O God; listen to my prayer. From the ends of the earth I call to you, I call as my heart grows faint; lead me to the rock that is higher than I. For you have been my refuge, a strong tower against the foe. I long to dwell in your tent forever and take refuge in the shelter of your wings.”

Focus: Ask the Lord to speak to you concerning a higher or expanded vision of following him.

Listen & Pray

Step 10.

Read: Isaiah 40:28-31



“Do you not know?

everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. Read: Matthew 7:9-11 &
